## CVS Health Shareholder Meeting Question Scott Shepard, Free Enterprise Project Coordinator National Center for Public Policy Research, May 14, 2020

I'm Scott Shepard of the National Center for Public Policy Research.

At last year's shareholder meeting, we asked you about your partnership with the Institute for Clinical and Economic Review (ICER), a nonprofit group that is working to establish "cost-effectiveness formulas" that would ration care by cutting it off from the most vulnerable. In recent weeks, when the COVID-19 scare was at its height, public officials gave instructions and made plans for exactly such triage at the expense of those communities. Will you announce to shareholders and to the public today that you do not support making such "cost-effectiveness formulas" a regular facet of American health care, and commit to ending funding for any organizations or programs that embrace such an approach?
